TREE planting is just one of the activities available under the **Healthy Country** project in the Lockyer to help landowners improve primary production as well as waterway health.

SEQ Catchments is coordinating these works to reduce soil loss across the landscape and improve ground cover as well as promoting best land management practices.

Maintaining vegetation cover on the slopes and creek banks is one of the simplest and most cost effective ways to maintain both healthy soil and water.

Native vegetation, including trees, shrubs and grasses are tolerant of local climate conditions and cover the soil well to minimise erosion.

Grazing management activities, riparian fencing, works to control erosion and land management workshops are some of the other activities available under the **Healthy Country** project.
